Sydney Metro — Western Sydney Airport

STATION BOXES & TUNNELLING (SBT) · SYDNEY · COMPLETED JAN 2025



Scope of Works

An-Co provided full access solutions to support the construction of four Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) for the Sydney Metro Western Sydney Airport line. The scope began with TBM access and expanded to full project access, making An-Co the sole scaffolding contractor across the entire SBT package. Works supported multiple construction fronts including TBM launch and retrieval, conveyor systems for tunnel spoil removal, excavation support for major station boxes and access for multiple trades as excavation progressed to final levels. Over 60 full-time scaffolders were deployed throughout the project with a total value of \$15 million to An-Co.

Overview

The SBT package delivers the primary underground works for the new metro line connecting St Marys, Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport and Bradfield. Delivered by CPB Contractors and Ghella, the package includes station boxes at St Marys, Orchard Hills, Luddenham, Airport Terminal and Bradfield, twin-bore metro tunnels linking all stations, and ground support systems forming the core of the new 23-kilometre metro line.

Outcome

Strong performance across the project led to ongoing engagement for additional access solutions. The project has strengthened An-Co's long-term relationships with key clients, many of whom have continued to engage An-Co as they move into new roles across the industry.

Upper South Creek Water Treatment Plant

Scope of Works

An-Co delivered full scaffolding access solutions for the construction and installation of the Upper South Creek Water Treatment Plant for John Holland. The scope included modular scaffold across the project, stretcher stairs, edge protection, full access to two depilator tanks, confined space access and suspended platforms. As the project evolved, An-Co's scope expanded with it. Originally engaged for the bioreactor MBR and digester, An-Co took on additional scaffold across the inlet areas, admin buildings, brine tanks and all switch rooms, supporting every trade on site including electrical, pipework, mechanical and maintenance crews throughout both construction and fitout phases.

Overview

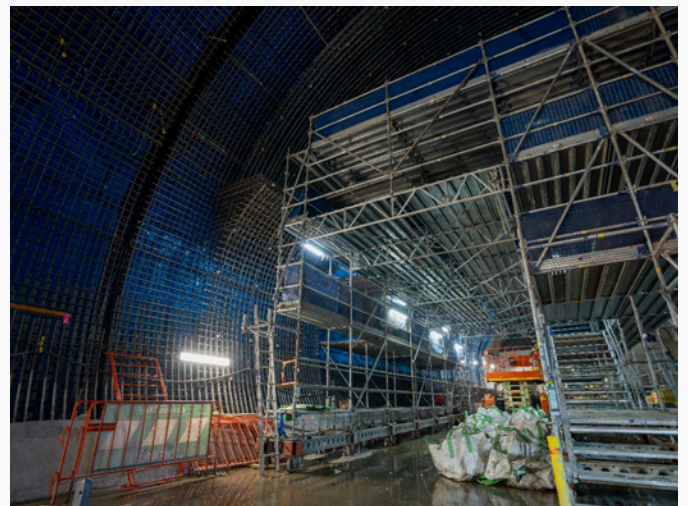
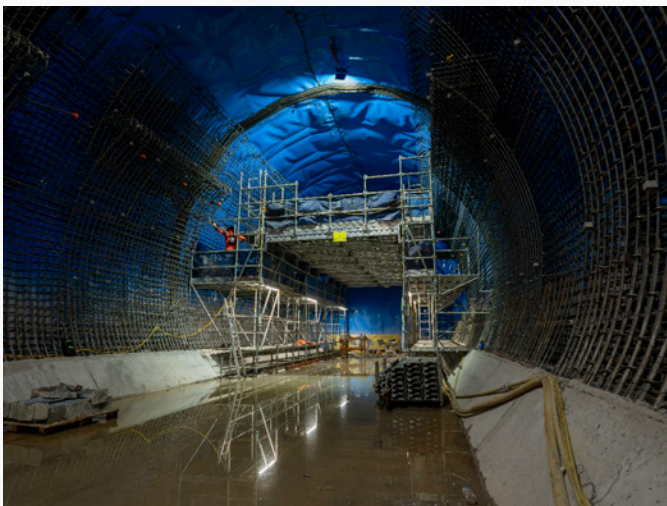
At its peak, the An-Co team comprised more than 10 scaffolders on site. A key feature of the delivery was the design and installation of craneable scaffold systems for areas where no existing access solution existed. Temporary works designs were completed, with structures lifted into place by crane and removed the same way once works were complete. Close coordination across multiple supervisors and trades was maintained throughout both phases of the project.

Outcome

An-Co delivered safe and reliable access for John Holland across the full duration of the project with no safety incidents recorded. Early planning, proactive coordination and a strong working relationship with the client were central to the project's success. An-Co remained on site through to the commissioning and testing phase, supporting John Holland through to final handover.

Sydney Metro — Eastern Tunnelling Package

Scope of Works

An-Co delivered all major scaffolding works across the Eastern Tunnelling Package, including critical site access solutions into the east and west shafts at the Hunter Street Station site. Over 450 tonnes of scaffolding were installed across the project, with a workforce of more than 25 scaffolders deployed throughout.

Overview

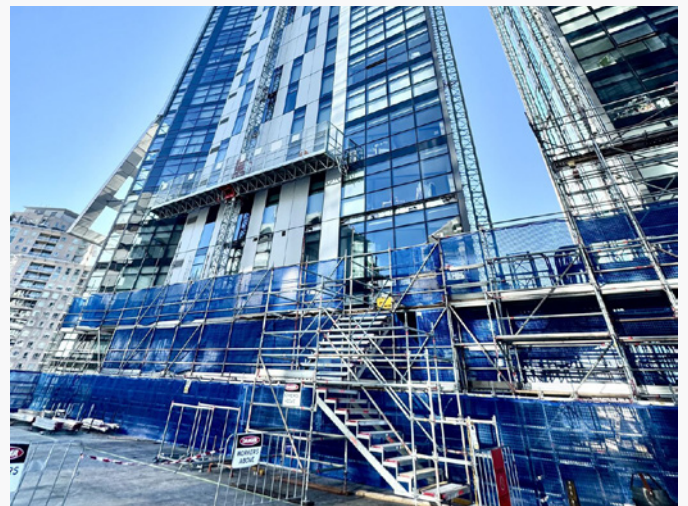
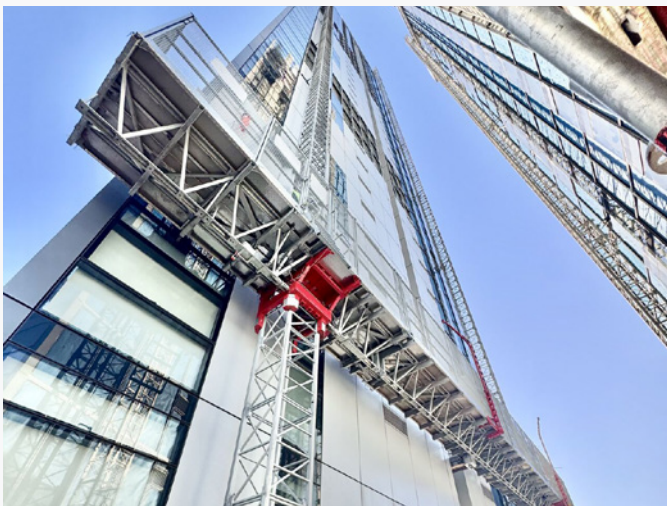
A key feature of the delivery was the implementation of rolling scaffolding systems, which reduced labour requirements and programme time by minimising repeated stripping and rebuilding of scaffold structures. The project required close coordination with multiple contractors to maintain safe and uninterrupted operations across all work fronts.

Outcome

An-Co's rolling scaffold approach improved overall site efficiency while maintaining safe access throughout. The project demonstrated An-Co's capacity to manage high-volume access requirements on major infrastructure, supporting ongoing tunnelling and construction activities at one of Sydney's most complex underground sites.

Chatswood Metro Towers — Remediation

Scope of Works

An-Co provided access solutions for the remediation works at Chatswood Metro Towers, working alongside RM Watson to support the replacement of combustible cladding as part of the Government remediation program. The scope comprised seven mast climber units with 15-metre tie spacings, utilising An-Co's Scanclimber equipment.

Overview

All works were completed within a live operational environment with ongoing train operations adjacent to the site. Delivery required detailed planning and strict safety controls throughout, with the Scanclimber system providing safe and efficient facade access while maintaining minimal impact on the existing structure.

Outcome

An-Co successfully delivered complex access solutions safely and efficiently in a high-risk and heavily constrained environment. The project demonstrated An-Co's capability in combining in-house access expertise with specialist mast climbing equipment to meet the demands of a technically challenging and time-sensitive remediation program.

Sydney Metro West — Western Tunnelling Package

Scope of Works

An-Co delivered all scaffolding access solutions for the TBM build and demobilisation works at Rosehill and Sydney Olympic Park for Gamuda, supporting the assembly and disassembly of tunnel boring machines. The scope also included the construction of two specialised hanging stretcher access systems within the Parramatta Station boxes, designed to accommodate ongoing excavation works with integrated lift access installed and progressively extended as excavation advanced. An-Co additionally provided access solutions for the FRP scope at both Clyde and Westmead, including the installation of heavy-duty headwall scaffolding structures weighing up to 80 tonnes.

Overview

The project required detailed staging, complex engineering coordination and close collaboration with tunnelling and excavation teams across multiple sites. A workforce of 30 scaffolders was deployed throughout, with works spanning TBM assembly, station box access and major structural scaffolding across the wider package.

Project Currently in Progress
